WOLF "ELIMINATOR" CONTEST RULES

THE WOLF "ELIMINATOR" CONTEST (THE "**CONTEST**") WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO ONLY AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. PARTICIPANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE "**CONTEST RULES**").

1. ELIGIBILITY.

1.1 To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:

- (a) be a legal resident of the province of Ontario;
- (b) be of the age of majority or older at the time of entry in the province of Ontario; and
- (c) reside within a one hundred (100) kilometer radius of the city of Peterborough, Ontario.

1.2 The following people are not eligible to enter the Contest:

- (a) Employees of Corus Radio Inc., operating as CKWF-FM (the "**Station**") and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (together with the Station, "**Corus**");
- (b) Employees of Chemong Chimney, Composite Deck Shop, Focus Flooring Centre, Head Rush Tattoo, Lakeshore Designs, Lakeview Bowl, Liftlock Family Dentistry, Marty Moos Family Restaurant, Peterborough Transmission, James Campbell Inc. and each of their affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (together with Corus, the "**Sponsors**");
- (c) Any person who has been confirmed as a winner of any Station administered contests within two (2) years preceding the Contest start date indicated below where the prize was valued over two thousand five hundred Canadian dollars (CDN \$2,500.00); and
- (d) The household members of any of the parties listed in Section (a) to (c) above.

1.3 The Sponsors shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the Sponsors for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply information that does not meet these requirements.

2. CONTEST PERIOD. The Contest begins at 7:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("**ET**") on September 5, 2023 and ends at 4:00 p.m. ET on September 28, 2023 (the "**Contest Period**") after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

3. HOW TO ENTER.

- 3.1 There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. To enter listen to the Station Monday through Friday during the Contest Period (excluding statutory holidays) at approximately 7:25 a.m. and in the 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. ET hours for the cue to text (the “**Cue to Text**”) to be played. Upon hearing the Cue to Text, listeners are invited to text 705-740-9653 (the “**Contest Line**”).
- 3.2 Limit of one (1) entry per person, per Cue to Text. In the case of multiple entries, only the first eligible entry will be considered.
- 3.3 Standard data service charges may apply through the text entry; check carrier plan for standard data usage charges. Entrants are solely responsible for any fees or data charges related to the text entry.
- 3.4 All entries become the sole property of the Sponsors and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of each Cue to Text. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.
- 3.5 Entries received by text-message shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the cell phone number associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, “authorized account holder” of a cell phone number is defined as the natural person who is assigned to a cell phone account by a cellular service provider. Any entrant may be required to provide the Sponsors with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the cell phone number associated with their entry.
- 3.6 Streaming listeners may be listening to a delayed stream of the radio signal, which may vary depending on the device on which you are listening and the speed of the internet connection. Sponsors recommend turning on a radio to the Station for the Cue to Text. Sponsors assume no liability for entrants not making timely texts to the Station due to delays in the streamed signal.
- 3.7 If the telephone connection between the Station announcer and an entrant is not clear, such that the announcer and/or entrant cannot hear each other or the entrant is disconnected, that entrant may, in the sole discretion of the Sponsors, be disqualified and the Releasees (defined in Section 7 below) will not be liable in any way.

4. PRIZES.

- 4.1 There are fifty-four (54) qualifying prizes (each, a “**Qualifying Prize**”, collectively the “**Qualifying Prizes**”) available to be won by the Qualifying Prize winners (each, a “**Qualifier**”, collectively the “**Qualifiers**”) each of which consists one (1) *McDonald’s* extra value meal prize pack, valued at approximately thirty Canadian dollars (CDN\$30.00).
- 4.2 There is one (1) grand prize (the “**Grand Prize**”) available to be won by the Grand Prize winner (the “**Grand Prize Winner**”) consisting of one (1) of the following Grand Prizes that remain at the end of the Contest Period:
 - (a) Three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00);
 - (b) A modern dynasty sofa with coordinating accent chair with track arms in custom fabric as selected by the Grand Prize Winner from Lakeshore Designs;

- (c) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) gift card from Composite Deck Shop;
- (d) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) gift card from Focus Flooring Centre;
- (e) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) gift card from Head Rush Tattoo;
- (f) Up to twelve (12) people, two (2) lanes for two (2) hours including two (2) large pizzas and pop once a month for a year from Lakeview Bowl;
- (g) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) gift card from Liftlock Family Dentistry;
- (h) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) gift card from Marty Moos Family Restaurant;
- (i) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) gift card towards service at Peterborough Transmission;
- (j) An electric fireplace from Chemong Chimney;
- (k) A Gibson Les Paul guitar with amplifier;
- (l) A Sony Smart TV;
- (m) A Macbook Pro and Air Pods;
- (n) A propane barbeque;
- (o) Five hundred four (504) Starbucks grande size pumpkin spice lattes;
- (p) A billiards table;
- (q) An e-bike;
- (r) A washer and dryer;
- (s) A photography kit, which shall include a Nikon camera and lenses;
- (t) A set of golf clubs;
- (u) A gaming PC and bundle;
- (v) A trampoline;
- (w) Camping gear, which shall include a tent, stove and sleeping bags;
- (x) Snowboard prize pack including snowboard, gloves and helmet;
- (y) Four (4) kayaks and four (4) life jackets;
- (z) A 4K drone;
- (aa) A golf membership;
- (bb) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) travel voucher;
- (cc) Winter skis, gloves and helmet;
- (dd) Lawnmower and gardening set;
- (ee) Winter tires and service;
- (ff) Harley Davidson merchandise and accessories;
- (gg) Fishing rods and accessories;
- (hh) A patio furniture set;
- (ii) Four (4) Toronto Blue Jays tickets and merchandise;
- (jj) 30-inch W 22 cu.ft. bottom freezer drawer refrigerator;
- (kk) A snowblower;
- (ll) Two (2) Peterborough Petes season tickets;
- (mm) A riding lawnmower;
- (nn) A four (4) piece PEARL drum set with accessories;
- (oo) A mini KORG synthesizer;
- (pp) A king size mattress;
- (qq) A mountain bike and accessories;
- (rr) A whiskey barrel Pacman game;
- (ss) Two (2) player mini upright with stand arcade machine;
- (tt) A double oven electric range;
- (uu) Backyard discovery sky fort III swing set;
- (vv) One hundred (100) vinyl records;
- (ww) Galvanized steel storage shed with high gable roof 12-ft x 10-ft;

- (xx) An 80 gallon air compressor;
- (yy) Six thousand twenty-four (6,024) glow sticks;
- (zz) Four hundred thirty (430) rising crust frozen pizzas;
- (aaa) A home gym setup with treadmill, weights, peloton etc.
- (bbb) Ten thousand (10,000) rolls of toilet paper; or
- (ccc) A three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00) Yeti shopping spree.

4.3 Each Grand Prize has an approximate value of three thousand Canadian dollars (CDN \$3,000.00).

4.4 Grand Prizes and Qualifying Prizes are hereafter collectively referred to as “**Prize**” or “**Prizes**”. Grand Prize Winner and Qualifiers are hereafter collectively referred to as a “**Winner**” or “**Winners**”.

4.5 Winners are not entitled to monetary difference between actual Prize value and stated approximate Prize value, if any.

4.6 The Sponsors and/or the Sponsors’ representatives will contact the Winners to coordinate the provision of the Prizes within two (2) days once such Winners have been successfully contacted and notified of their Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

5. **PRIZE CONDITIONS.**

5.1 All bookings and/or reservations are subject to availability at time of booking.

5.2 Winners will be responsible for any other expense not explicitly included in a Prize.

5.3 In the case of event tickets, gift cards or gift certificates, the terms by which the event tickets, gift cards or gift certificates may be redeemed are governed by the applicable retailer or service provider. Corus is not responsible for administering or ensuring compliance with the terms and conditions of the event tickets, gift cards or gift certificates.

5.4 Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash, except at the sole discretion of the Sponsors. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of a Prize will be forfeited, have no cash value and the Sponsors shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if a Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason.

5.5 Shipped Prizes shall not be insured and the Sponsors shall not assume any liability for lost, damaged or misdirected Prizes.

6. **WINNER SELECTION.**

6.1 **Qualifier Selection.** Fifty-four (54) Qualifiers shall be selected as follows:

- (a) Approximately five (5) minutes after each Cue to Text is announced, one (1) entrant will be randomly selected from each Cue to Text pool of entrants and must answer the call from the Station in order to be eligible to receive a Qualifying Prize and be entered into the draw for a chance to win the Grand Prize.
- (b) If the Station is unable to reach the selected entrant or the call back goes to voicemail

(whichever comes first), another eligible entrant will be randomly selected.

- (c) The Qualifier shall also be required to either: (i) select one (1) Grand Prize to be eliminated from the list of Grand Prizes available to be won; (ii) select two (2) Grand Prizes to be eliminated from the list of Grand Prizes available to be won; or (iii) bring back a previously eliminated Grand Prize from the list of previously eliminated Grand Prizes, as directed by the Station during each Cue to Text.
- (d) Each selected entrant shall be eligible to win only one (1) Qualifying Prize per household during the Contest Period.

6.2 Grand Prize Winner Selection. One (1) Grand Prize Winner shall be selected as follows:

- (a) On or about September 29, 2023 in Peterborough, Ontario, one (1) Qualifier will be selected by a random draw from all Qualifiers during the Contest Period.
- (b) THE SELECTED QUALIFIER WILL BE NOTIFIED BY TELEPHONE AND/OR E-MAIL NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 29, 2023 AT 9:00 A.M. ET AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION.

6.3 The odds of being selected as a potential winner are dependent upon the number of eligible entries received by Corus. Before being declared a Winner, each selected entrant shall be required to correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered during a pre-arranged telephone call or by e-mail to comply with the Contest Rules and to sign and return the Release (described below).

6.4 Upon notification, each selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, they will be disqualified and will not receive a Prize and another entrant may be selected in the Sponsors' sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. The Sponsors are not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for the Sponsors to receive a selected entrant's response.

6.5 If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.

7. **RELEASE.** Potential Winners will be required to execute a legal agreement and release ("**Release**") that confirms each potential Winner's: (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of each of the Sponsors and each of their employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the "**Releasees**") from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to the Sponsors of the unrestricted right, in the Sponsors' collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner's name, statements,

image, likeness, voice and biography, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within two (2) business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as a Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.

- 8. INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT.** By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, exposure to the COVID-19 virus, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims made by third parties relating to the entrant's participation in the Contest, without limitation.
- 9. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.** The Sponsors assume no responsibility or liability for lost, late, unintelligible/illegible, falsified, damaged, misdirected or incomplete entries, notifications, responses, replies or any Release, or for any telephone, hardware or technical malfunctions that may occur, including but not limited to malfunctions that may affect the transmission or non-transmission of an entry. The Sponsors are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. The Sponsors assume no responsibility or liability in the event that the Contest cannot be conducted as planned for any reason, including reasons beyond the control of the Sponsors, such as tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or corruption of the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest.
- 10. CONDUCT.** By participating in the Contest, each entrant is deemed to have executed and agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules, which will be posted throughout the Contest Period. Each entrant further agrees to be bound by the decisions of the Sponsors, which shall be final and binding in all respects. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant found to be: (a) violating the Contest Rules; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any Corus property or service; and/or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass the Sponsors or any other person. **CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE SPONSORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SEEK REMEDIES AND DAMAGES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CRIMINAL PROSECUTION.**
- 11. PRIVACY / USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION.**

 - 11.1 By entering the Contest, each entrant expressly consents to Corus, and its third-party agents and service providers, to collect, use, store, and share any personal information submitted by entrant to enter the Contest, such as name, age of majority confirmation, and contact information, as applicable, only for the purpose of implementing, administering, and fulfilling the Contest as described in these Contest Rules, and in accordance with Corus' Privacy Policy, available at <http://www.corusent.com/privacy-policy>.
 - 11.2 Each Winner further consents that: (a) any personal information they have provided in connection with this Contest may be shared with prize providers for the purpose of facilitating the delivery or fulfillment of a Prize; and (b) Corus may broadcast, publish, disseminate and otherwise use a

Winner's name, city/town/village and province/territory of residence, image and/or voice in connection with any promotion and/or publicity purposes without further compensation to Winner.

11.3 No communication unrelated to the Contest, commercial or otherwise, will be sent to the entrant unless the entrant otherwise expressly agrees to receive further communications from Sponsors.

12. **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.** All intellectual property, including but not limited to trade-marks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations is owned by the Sponsors and/or their affiliates. 13. **TERMINATION.** The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, and/or modify, amend or suspend the Contest, and/or the Contest Rules in any way, at any time, for any reason without prior notice.
14. **LAW.** These are the official Contest Rules. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over the Sponsors. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and the Sponsors in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws.
15. **DISCREPANCY.** In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including but not limited to the Contest entry form, or point of sale, television, print or online advertising, the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules shall prevail, govern and control.
16. **SOCIAL MEDIA.** This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by any social media platforms on which the Contest may have been promoted and/or publicized. Any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest must be directed to Corus.
